Overview of Headquarters Relocation Promotion Grant

Companies that relocate offices which function as headquarters and conduct business in Nagano are eligible to have a portion of their costs subsidized.

Eligible facilities

Offices, laboratories, and training centers operating as headquarters
Satellite offices operating as headquarters

Grant Requisites

- 1. Relocation of headquarters functions from outside of Nagano to inside the prefecture
- 2. Hiring of 5 or more additional full-time employees (2 or more for small and medium-size companies) to carry out headquarters functions
- 3. Registration with the Nagano Prefecture Registry of Businesses Promoting the SDGs
- 4. Submission of an operational climate change mitigation action plan

Applications for business approval must be submitted, in principle, 14 days prior to the day a business begins headquarters construction, enters into a lease agreement, or begins headquarters relocation (when neither construction nor a lease agreement are required), whichever comes first.
